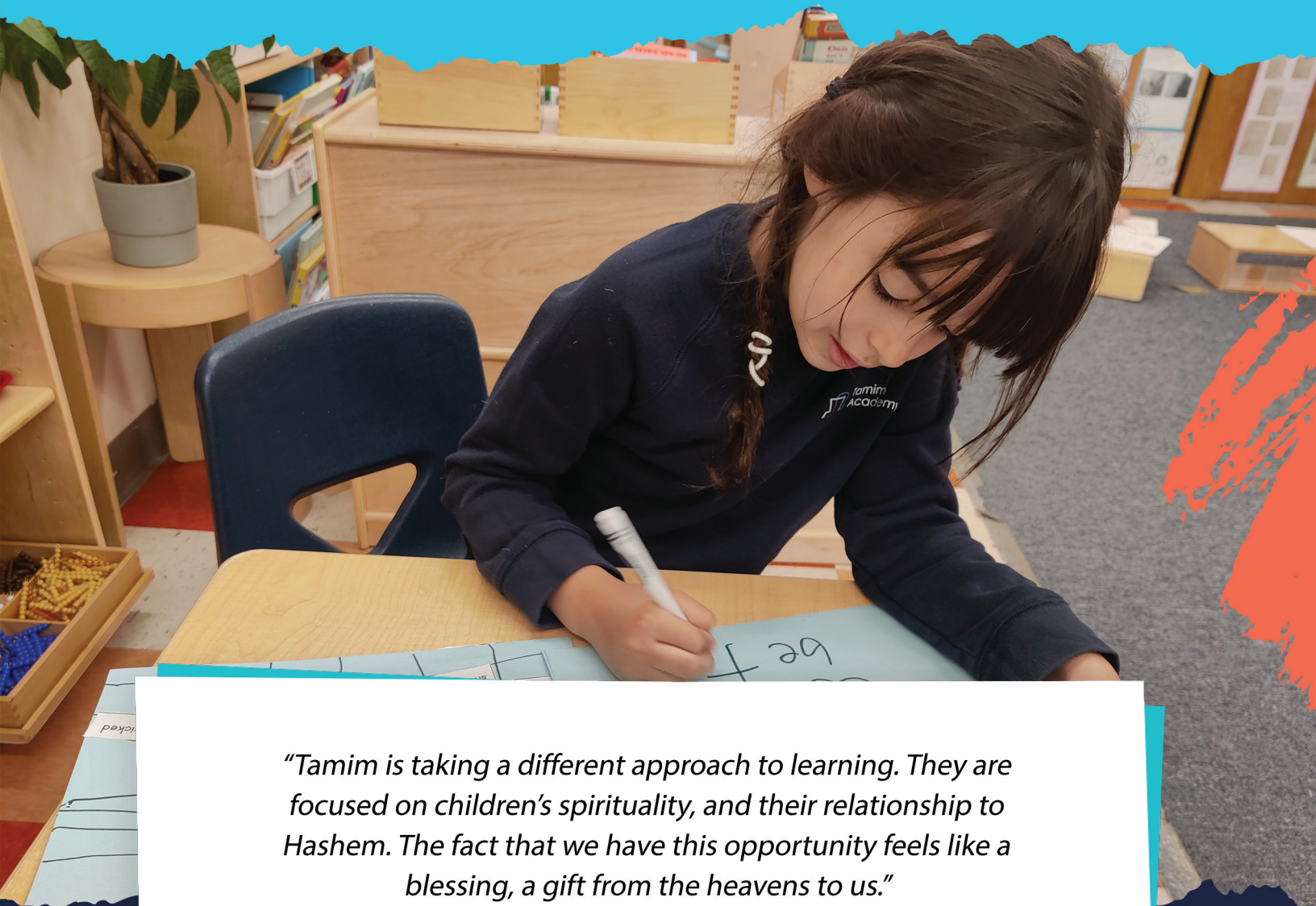

# Our Roots

## תמים

Our name is sourced from Tomchei Temimim, the first formal Yeshiva system of the Chabad-Lubavitch movement. Founded in 1897 by Rabbi Sholom DovBer Schneerson in the town of Lubavitch, Russia, each student was lovingly called “tamim,” meaning pure, perfect or complete. This term of endearment packs a vital message: quality Jewish education begins with the assumption that each child is inherently holy and good.



This concept of **“wholeness”** is the foundation of our model of Jewish education.

# Indoor and outdoor classes

Our indoor classrooms are designed with Montessori principles in mind. Huge windows allow natural light to enter, low open shelves are accessible to children, and child-friendly furniture encourages children to own their space.

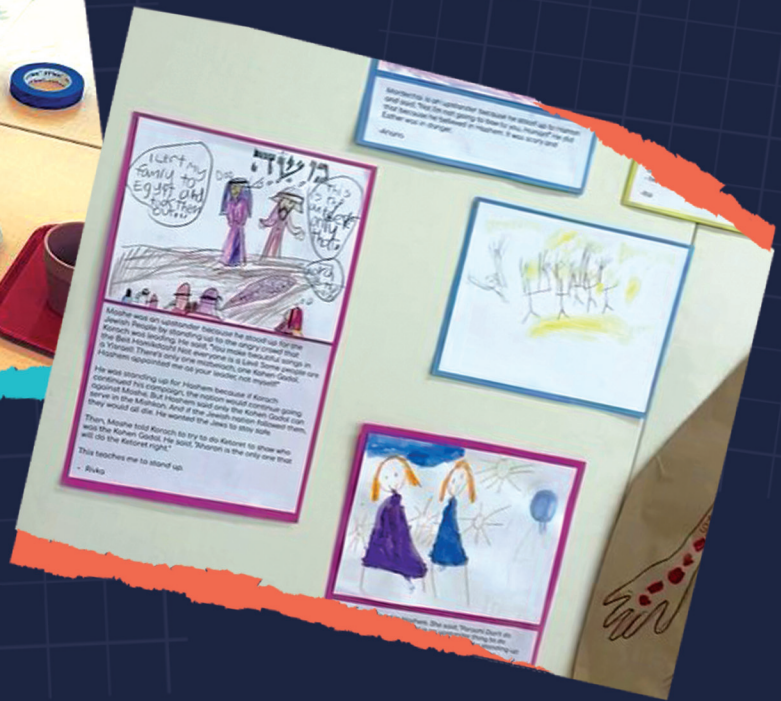

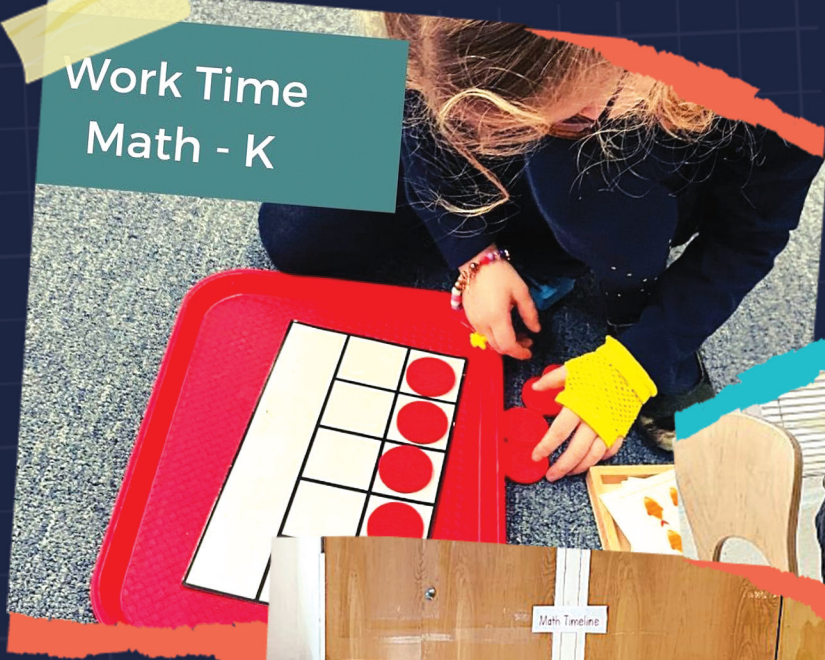

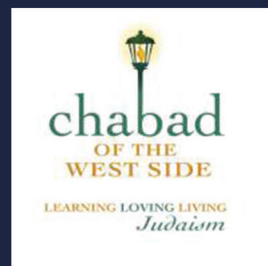
