Sharing This Week's Learning With You.

This week, Tamim learners continued strengthening their relationship with Israel by drawing pictures and writing messages for soldiers currently serving. They also decorated 'pushkas' (money boxes) kindly donated by Isabel and Daniel Mael, which they have brought home together with their first bag of pennies to use for their tzedaka. Kindergarten learned the k, u, and b sounds, while 1st grade extending their 'special friends' spelling skills, now writing sentences such as, 'I got a fright in the night!' Everyone really enjoyed learning different lyrit food words as well as mixing different paint colors to create symmetrical pictures.

LEARNING TORAH VALUES AT TAMIM NYC! Each week at Tamim we focus on a different value, middah or positive character trait drawn from the week's parasha (Torah portion). The children have so far this year explored the themes of appreciating our world, and what it means to be a good influence on others. This week's Parshat Lech Lecha learning included meaningful conversations about promises and trust.

ELA 1st grade: How many words can you think of with 'igh' and 'ay' sounds?

ELA K: How many words can you think of with the 'b' and 'd' sounds?

Can you 'Fred talk' m-a-t and b-i-g to make words?

ART: What happens when we mix colors? What color do we see when we mix: blue and yellow, blue and red, red and yellow?

<u>KRIAK K:</u> The 'body' of a word is the beginning of the word, (שַׁ is the body of ...). Ask me what is the body of these words and which words have the same body? עץ, אָשׁ, הַר, דֶר, דַג

KRIAH 1st Grade: How many shuruk (וּ) words can you find in a siddur?
Try and make a 'story' using these words: סוּס, מַבּוּל, סוּכָּה, חוּם, אָסוּר
IVRIT: Can you use these food words in a sentence, or even find them at home?
תוֹרַס (apple), (corn) עוֹגָה, תַּפּוּחַ (apple), (corn)
